



Tieman's new NSW division sets high standards

Tieman has recently moved into a new location in Sydney. It is just around the corner from the previous location but is a much larger premise at 4 Davis Rd, Wetherill Park.

At the recent opening a number of key customers visited and were able to view the latest product range on display by Tieman.

Tieman welcomes customers to visit the facility and see the effects to air flow provided by the Big Ass Fan for themselves. Joint Managing Director Dale Tieman commented, "The new premise is great for our staff. It will also allow us to further grow our business in NSW through providing a better, more efficient customer service."

As well as opening the new facility, Tieman is also celebrating 30 years since Tieman entered the Sydney/NSW market in its own right with the purchase of R.R. Franklin Engineering in Chullora in 1980.

Tieman now has 20 mobile service vans operating throughout Sydney and NSW providing seven day, 24 hour after sales service to its range of Tail Lifts, Vehicle Access Wheelchair Loaders, Materials Handling and Dock Safety Equipment; as well as servicing products from other manufacturers.

Tieman can also offer national coverage with over 60 service vans around Australia. The company's national contract service reporting simplifies administration for national customers.

"It is a significant investment in NSW but it is a show of confidence in our team, the local NSW market and is a win-win for Tieman and our customers." said Dale.
