**RADIO RENTALS** HAS CONTINUED ITS LONG-STANDING RELATIONSHIP WITH **TIEMAN** BY RECENTLY ADDING 11 NEW VANS TO ITS FLEET, ALL FITTED WITH THE LATEST DHOLLANDIA BY TIEMAN ALUMINIUM PLATFORM TAIL LIFTS.

Established in 1937, the company now operates 233 vehicles including trucks, vans and station wagons across its 75 stores; employing more than 500 members of staff.

The latest order of 11 new vans have been put to work at various stores throughout Australia delivering a wide range of products including televisions, computers, furniture and fitness equipment.

The decision was made to have these vans fitted with Tieman supplied DH-LSP 500 Dholandia tail lifts which are specifically designed for easy fitting to factory built vans without the need to cut into the vans rear bumper bar structure. According to Tieman, these tail lifts are perfect for light distribution work due to their exceptional performance and ease of use.

Capable of lifting up to 500kg, the DH-LSP 500 is fully tested prior to leaving the Tieman installation facility. For increased operator safety, the lightweight 1550mm x 1450mm full aluminium platform features

a non-slip surface. Whilst on the ground, the platform is protected by synthetic rollers; and during lifting, maximum lateral stability is provided by the unit's wide arm centre.

Maintenance is also kept simple. The tail lift's frame and lift arms are finished in polyester powder coating for maximum durability.

For excellent platform stability, the DH-LSP 500 features two single acting lift cylinders, as well as one platform tilt cylinder for powered control of the platform opening and closing function. Each of these cylinders feature solenoid check valves to ensure hose burst protection.

The new batch of tail lifts have now been in service since November and the positive feedback from Radio Rentals indicates that these units have been going great. “We have had no issues with the new tail lifts at all – they have been going really well.”

Tieman also provide National 24/7 service support for tail lifts helping to keep important assets working well and safely.
